Here's the exact arsenal top Laravel developers use daily:

1. **php artisan serve** → Start local development server
2. **php artisan make:controller ControllerName** → Create a new controller class
3. **php artisan make:model ModelName** → Generate a new Eloquent model
4. **php artisan make:migration create_table_name** → Create a new database migration file
5. **php artisan migrate** → Run all pending migrations
6. **php artisan migrate:rollback** → Rollback the last batch of migrations
php artisan make:seeder SeederName → Create a new database seeder class.
7. **php artisan migrate:fresh --seed** → Drop all tables, migrate & seed database fresh
8. **php artisan db:seed** → Seed the database with test/dummy data
9. **php artisan tinker** → Interactively work with app data in CLI
10. **php artisan config:cache** → Cache the config files for faster performance
11. **php artisan route:cache** → Cache route definitions to improve load time
12. **php artisan view:cache** → Compile & cache Blade templates
13. **php artisan cache:clear** → Clear the application cache
14. **php artisan optimize:clear** → Clear all caches (config, route, view, etc.)

15. **php artisan route:list** → List all registered routes in the app
16. **php artisan make:middleware MiddlewareName** → Create a new middleware class
17. **php artisan queue:work** → Start processing the queue jobs
18. **php artisan queue:restart** → Restart queue workers after code change
19. **php artisan make:policy PolicyName** → Generate a new authorization policy
20. **php artisan make:request RequestName** → Create a new form request validation class
21. **php artisan make:event EventName** → Create a new event class
22. **php artisan make:listener ListenerName** → Create a new event listener class
23. **php artisan down** → Put the application into maintenance mode
24. **php artisan up** → Bring the application back up from maintenance mode
25. **php artisan install:api** → Restores the api.php route file crucial for API-first applications

php artisan install:broadcasting → Rebuilds the broadcasting.php config file to enable event broadcasting

php artisan install:testing → Regenerates the entire tests directory for Unit & Feature tests

php artisan install:exceptions → Restores the Exceptions directory & Handler.php for advanced error handling.

php artisan install:frontend → Brings back default frontend scaffolding (Blade + Vite + your preferred stack).
